• RideOn bus turnaround (Miriam Schoenbaum, Chair, Boyds MARC-MCDOT working group):

## Kelly Blynn (Coalition for Smarter Growth): Bus Rapid Transit Proposal for SR 355

• This transit system is described as light rail on rubber tires, basically a bus service but different. The frequency would be every 5-10 minutes; it would have its own lanes; buses would be bigger (articulated); the transit system would have its own stations and would be further apart (1/2 to 1 mile apart) than current bus systems making fewer stops to make it faster.
